Amanda Mohammed, MD, receives the Texas Academy of Family **Physicians Humanitarian Award**

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS — Amanda Mohammed, MD, of Dallas, Texas, has been awarded the Texas Academy of Family Physicians Humanitarian Award. Dr. Mohammed received the award during TAFP's Annual Session and Primary Care Summit in The Woodlands on Nov. 6. The award honors physicians who provide extraordinary and enduring humanitarian efforts.

Mohammed practices family medicine at Oak Street Health in Dallas. She is also a Volunteer Faculty Family Physician at UT Southwestern and AM Opportunities.

She was recognized for her work around the world, but also close to home. Dr. Mohammed worked in fundraising for AmeriCorps VISTA Habitat for Humanity in Oakland, California. She currently serves on the Young Professionals HIV/AIDS Advisory Council for The Resource Center Dallas, helping to fundraise and providing opportunities for life skills, leadership development, peer support, and educational advancement to LGBTQ+ youth in the Dallas area.

Mohammed has been an active member of numerous mission projects, associations, and advocacy campaigns. This includes a medical mission trip with Refuge International in 2018 to a remote community on the border river between Belize and Guatemala. The organization serves over 3,000 residents in the surrounding villages, many of whom do not have access to any other health care.

Family physicians like Mohammed are qualified to work in all major medical areas and trained to treat more than 90 percent of all cases they encounter. Family physicians care for patients of all ages.
